Minutes

Tuesday, April 2, 2019

Meeting was started at 6:00p at the Black Bear Diner on So. Virginia. 19 members attended. Presiding was Rod Gordon, president, with Susie Mason, Membership Coordinator.

April Run – Changed from April 13 to April 26th - The second Saturday of the month is reserved for our “Miata runs”. This month Van Johnston has offered to lead but has requested the run to be changed to Friday, April 26. The run will be to Fort Churchill State Historic Park. We will meet at the Summit Park & Ride (Mt. Rose Hwy/Herz Blvd.) at 9am. Please bring a packed lunch. Remember: A full tank and an empty bladder. Separate e-mail to be distributed for this run.

May Run – May 11th (the Saturday after the regular May meeting) - Rod and Susie Gordon will be leading. We will be going to the Kings Canyon Waterfall just west of downtown Carson City. It is a short uphill walk and probably will involve a packed lunch. More to come.

June 8th Run - We need leaders for the June 8 run. Any volunteers?

June 29th Poker Run – Member George Minter has asked if Reno Miata Club is interested in participating in a Poker Run sponsored by the Patriotic Knight Riders for Life. The run benefits the Wreaths Across America, an annual event honoring fallen military members, and Casa de Vida, a home for pregnant young women in need. The run will be Saturday June 29th. Additional details about the run are included in a brochure saved separately.

June or July – Date to be Determined - Dolan has an “Owners Appreciation Day” during the summer. The event includes food and drinks and celebrates Miata and Mazda car owners.

Raffle - There will be a raffle next meeting. Donation of prizes are welcome. Terri Schulte suggested to use one of our runs as a poker run. For a certain amount of money at the beginning of the run you would get to pick a card and again at multiple stops for a total of 5 cards. The best hand would get 50% of the “pot” and the rest would go into the kitty.

Christmas Party 2019 - Terri Schulte and Debbie Campbell are working on the Christmas party and asked if we wanted to mix up the restaurants and go to La Fuente in Sparks again. The rent of the room is \$100. There would be games and an ornament exchange. All agreed. Whitney Peak Hotel was suggested as an alternative and will be looked into.

Hot August Nights is coming up. August 6th thru 11th - Reno Miata Club is scheduled to assist for one of the nights. All were very enthusiastic to volunteer to help. We agreed to have 10 volunteers for 2 nights. Each night will be for 4 hours. We will volunteer together and under one leader but may be spread apart. We will be given Hot August Nights name badges but can wear a Miata t-shirt to promote the Miata Club. We can earn \$250/10 volunteers for each night. (**T-shirts will be addressed next meeting**)
