**New (stolen from Daves' motorcycle club) ideas for drives:**

- a.** Dave Schulte suggested that we set a day of the month for runs. The starting point would be the same place and time. The route and brunch spot would be decided upon at the start and Dave volunteered to lead. If you want to participate then just show up. After discussion and multiple suggestions, it was agreed upon that every third Wednesday of the month would be a good time for all/most. The starting point will be the Starbucks on Mt. Rose Hwy. Depart time will be 9:30. Come earlier if you want for coffee and bench racing.
- b.** Drive Challenge Destinations: This is to motivate people to "drive" and get out of town. A list of 20 to 40 destinations will be provided. Destinations will generally be a historical site, scenic place, or a good place to eat and include some fun roads. Hopefully, some places will be new for you and fun to discover.

An ante fee of \$20 will be charged. The object is to drive to different destinations and take a photo of a certain object to prove that you were there. You will earn points for each proved destination. More distant locations will be awarded more points. At the end of the challenge, a number of tickets will be given to each driver based on the number of accumulated points achieved. There will be a drawing for the prize money. More points equals more tickets and a better chance of winning. The first drawing winner will get 50% of the ante pot. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> runners up will each receive 25% of the ante pot. You can go as a single car or in groups of your own choosing and on your own schedule, not as a planned club event. You may want to devise loops that include several destinations in one drive. Maybe an over-nighter to extend your range.

The drawing will be done at the Christmas party so you will have the rest of the year to participate. Dave will design the destinations and e-mail more information.
